



PRODUCT DATA SHEET SWABS

Description

Swabs, sterile or non-sterile.

Intended use and mark

Devices for taking samples from natural orifices in the human body. All LP Swabs have the **CE** conformity marking as Medical Device, according to the procedure set out in Annex VII of Directive 93/42/EEC..

LP Sterile Swabs have the **CE** conformity marking together with the identification code of the Notified Body which periodically monitors the conformity of the product, obtained according to the procedure of annexes V and VII of Directive 93/42 / EEC (see Table A).

Indications of use

Swabs are means for manually collecting samples of bacterial flora from the human body.

This is possible thanks to the characteristics of the tip (cotton or Rayon) which facilitate collection without damaging the material.

Swabs do not operate autonomously, but require a professional operator in charge of the collection. They are simple and intuitive to use.

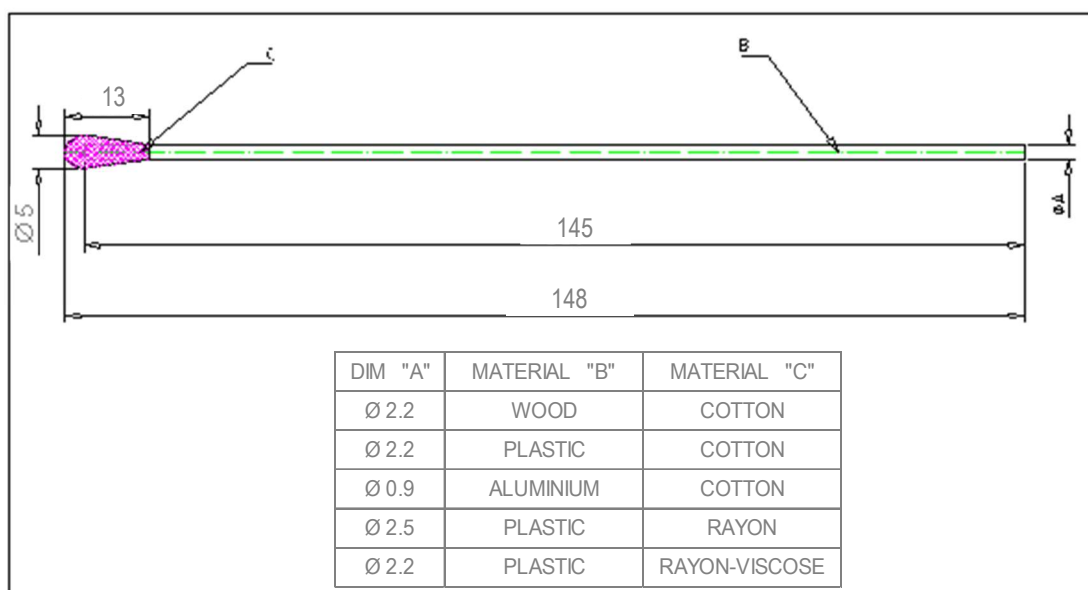
The collection usually takes place by means of a simple "smear" of the tip of the swab against the intact internal tissues of a patient's natural orifice, such as: nose and pharynx, eye, ear, respiratory system, vagina, rectum.

Swabs are disposable; the contact time with the patient is short (not more than one minute) and is intended to be used by professional operators on patients of any age.

Material

Manufactured in two different materials, cotton and Rayon. They may also have a plastic, wood or wire stick.

1. Packaging: In addition to the outer box
2. LDPE sealed bags x pieces
3. Individual single: Materials resistant to ionizing radiation
Blister: PA/PE (30/70) film and medical paper, 4 welded edges
Tube: In PS ø16x150 mm used as container, labelled; swab assembled with its stopper.
4. Individual double: Swab in a tube, packed in blister.
5. See chemical-physical specifications, page 2
6. Sterility: Where applicable swabs are irradiated to a SAL (Sterility Assurance Level) of 10⁻⁶, if package is unopened and undamaged.
7. Cultiplast swabs are MDD products registered with the National Directory of Medical Devices (NDMD).

LP swabs are disposable: once used, they must be disposed according to the instructions given at the locations where they are used.
