

PREHISTORIC MAN SKULL SET OF 6

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NEANDERTHALENSIS CRANIUM (F)

- Homo neanderthalensis
- Existed 400,000 – 40,000 Years Ago
 - Found in Europe and Southwestern to Central Asia

ERECTUS CRANIUM (D)

- Homo erectus
- Existed 1.89 Million – 143,000 Years Ago
 - Found in Northern, Eastern, and Southern Africa, Western Asia (Dmanisi, Republic of Georgia), and East Asia (China and Indonesia)

HABILIS CRANIUM (C)

- Homo habilis
- Existed 2.4 - 1.4 Million Years Ago
 - Found in Eastern and Southern Africa

AFRICANUS CRANIUM (B)

- Australopithecus africanus
- Existed 3.3 - 2.1 Million Years Ago
 - Found in Southern Africa (South Africa)

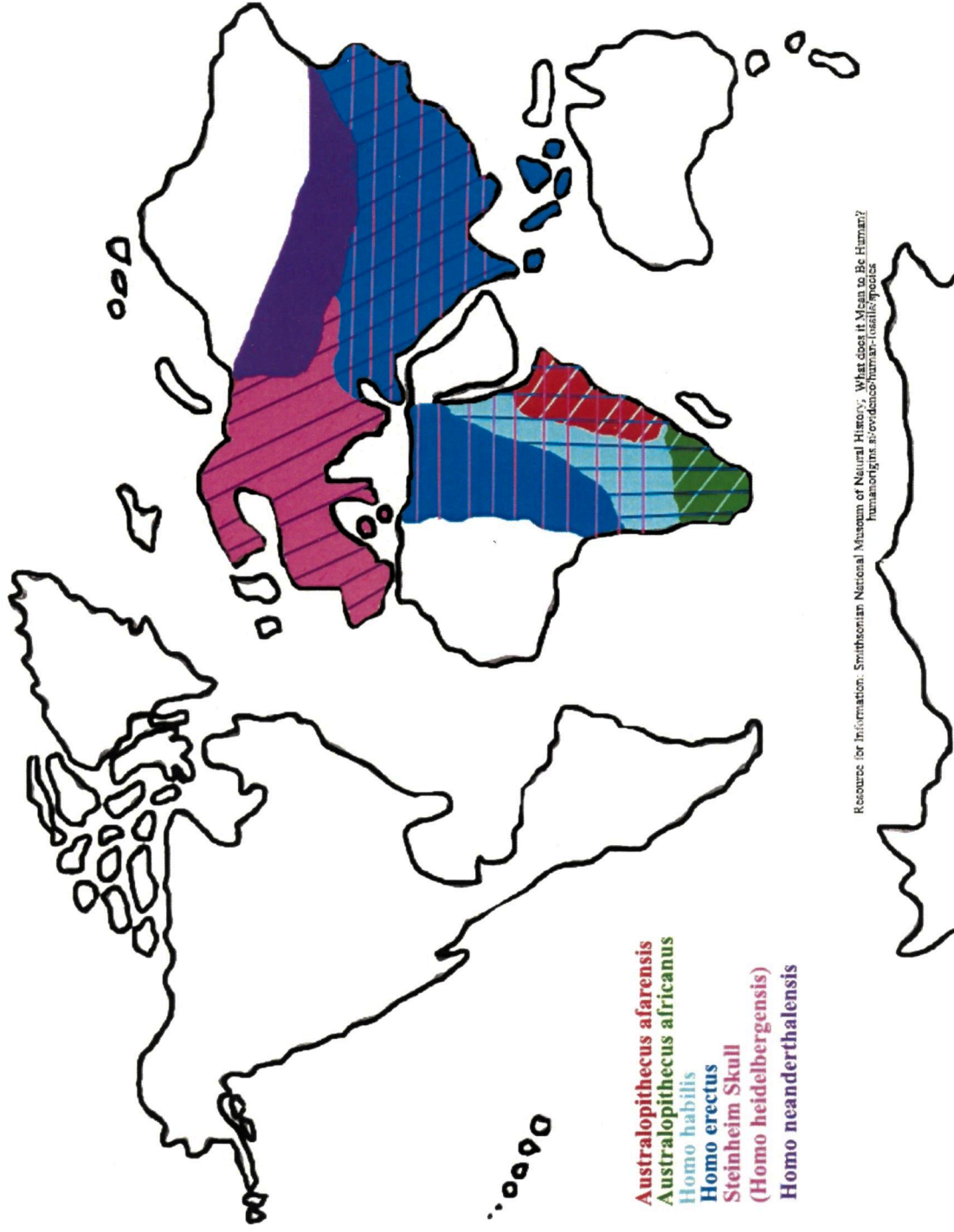
AFARENSIS CRANIUM (A)

- Australopithecus afarensis
- Existed 3.85 - 2.95 Million Years Ago
 - Found in Eastern Africa (Ethiopia, Kenya, and Tanzania)

STEINHEIM CRANIUM (E)

- Homo heidelbergensis
- Existed 700,000 - 200,000 Years Ago
 - Found in Europe, possibly Asia (China), and Africa (Eastern and Southern)
