

Mobile Tool Storage Caddy

The Mobile Tool Storage Caddy allows you to stay organized and easily bring your tools with you when working in your garden. It includes 18 pockets and 2 buckets, giving you plenty of space to store all of your tools, even your long-handled ones. You can take it with you while you work, so you will always have what you need on hand and can avoid making multiple trips.

Tools required

- Adjustable wrench
Allen wrench (included)

Assembly

Step 1. Identify and organize all parts on a clean, level surface.

Step 2. Slide a Wheel onto each end of the Axle with the flat side of the Wheel facing out (Figure 1). Find the Wheel Bolts with the hexagonal holes in the heads, and slide a Flat Gasket then a Spring Washer onto the ends of them. Place the Bolts through the center of the Wheels and use the included Allen Wrench to tighten them into place.

Step 3. Slide the Handle onto the top of the Base Support (Figure 2). The bottom two holes in the Handle should line up with the two holes in the top of the Base Support.

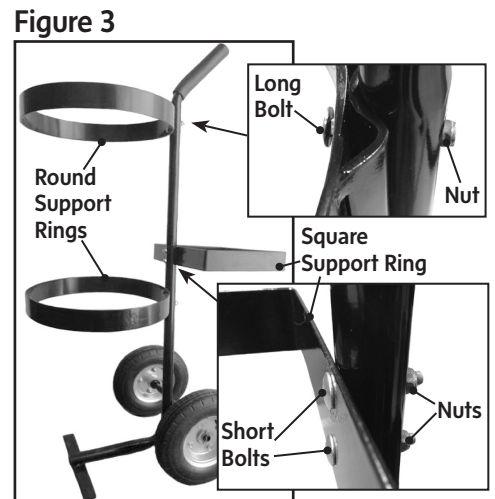
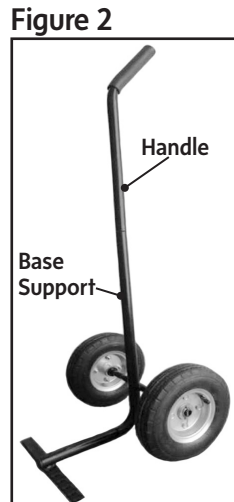
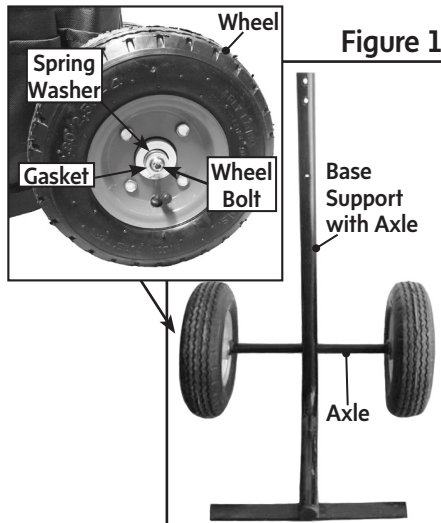
Step 4. Take a Round Support Ring and place it on the front of the Caddy, lining up the hole in the Ring with the bottom hole in the Base Support (Figure 3). Insert a Long Bolt through the lined up holes, starting with the hole in the Ring, and loosely attach a Lock onto the end of it. **NOTE:** Do not tighten the Nut yet.

Step 5. Repeat Step 4 to attach the other Round Support Ring to the top hole in the Handle, making sure the Ring is facing the front of the Caddy (Figure 3).

Step 6. Repeat Step 4, using the Short Bolts to attach the Square Support Ring to the lined up holes in the Handle and Base Support, with the Ring facing the back of the Caddy (Figure 3). Use an adjustable wrench to tighten all the Nuts and Bolts into place.



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Step 7. Attach the Tool Belt to the bottom Round Support Ring by folding the hook and loop strips around the Ring as shown in Figure 4. There is a hook strip attached to one end of the Tool Belt that should be placed over the Base Support and attached to the loop strip on the other end of the Belt (Figure 5).

Step 8. Place the Round Bucket into the bottom Round Support Ring and the Square Bucket into the Square Support Ring. Assembly is complete!

The Mobile Tool Storage Caddy should be stored in a protected location when not in use.

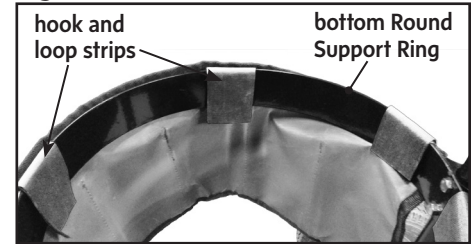
